

Beckton & Royal Docks Children's Centre Tip Sheet <u>Make a mini crown for your favourite toy</u>

This is a great craft for child to participate in to encourage imaginative play.

The crown can be worn by your child's favourite teddy bears or dolls!



<u>You will need:</u>

- Cardboard kitchen roll tube (This will make two crowns)
- Scissors (used with adult supervision)
- Child safe paint, pens, pencils or crayons
- Child safe glue
- Sparkly items to decorate: Glitter, gems, sequins etc.
- Ribbon, string or elastic
- Hole punch (optional)
- 1. Cut kitchen roll tube in half and then cut points to make a crown. Ensure adult
 - supervision when using the scissors.
 - 2. Decorate with paints, pencils, or crayons
 - 3. Once dry decorate with glitter, gems, or sequins
- 4. Make two holes near the bottom then thread through ribbon, string or elastic so that the crown will stay on the toys head.
