
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Materials needed:

Coloured paper, Scissors, Hole punch

Pencil or craft stick, Tape, Torch





How to Make Shadow Puppets

- 1. Cut several numbers or shapes out of the paper.
- 2. Allow the child to hole punch dots throughout the numbers. The use of a hole punch will help strengthen fine motor muscles in hands and create a really neat effect when the light is shown on the shadow puppet figures.
- 3. Tape the numbers to a pencil or craft stick.
- 4. In a dark room, shine the torch on the numbers. Explore what happens when the shadow puppet moves closer and further from the light source.
- 5. Have fun!
