

Beckton & Royal Docks Children's Centre Tip Sheet Conker Paint Rolling

You will need:

- Conkers/acorns/pinecones
- Child safe paint in different colours
- Paper or card (you could also empty boxes/packets)
- Tray



If at this time of year you often come home from a walk in the park and find the children's pockets full of conkers then this is a fun way to be creative with all those conkers! You can also try using acorns or pinecones.

This is a great activity for this time of year. Go on a scavanger hunt to see what you can find in your local park, talk to your children about Autumn and the changes that it brings, falling leaves and conkers, changing colours.

- Lay the paper or card in a tray or the bottom of a cardboard box.
- Put a few blobs of different coloured paint onto the paper.
- Add the conkers to the tray and then gently roll the conkers around to create different patterns.
